Stonehill International School Academic & Sports Scholarship Programme 2018-19

The aim of the Stonehill International School Academic and Sports Scholarship Programme is to foster and celebrate academic excellence. Scholarships are awarded to candidates who demonstrate outstanding academic and sports abilities, based on aptitude and potential.

Academic Scholarships are awarded at the following grade levels:

- Grade 9 (M4) - Age 14+ (Max. age limit: 15 years)
- Grade 10 (M5) - Age 15+ (Max. age limit: 16 years)
- Grade 11 (D1) - Age 16+ (Max. age limit: 17 years)

Sports Scholarships are awarded at the following grade levels:

- Grade 8 (M3) - Age 13+ (Max. age limit: 14 years)
- Grade 9 (M4) - Age 14+ (Max. age limit: 15 years)
- Grade 10 (M5) - Age 15+ (Max. age limit: 16 years)

Scholarship Categories:

- Scholarships with a tuition fee concession of 100%, 75% or 50%
- Scholarships with a boarding fee concession of 50%
- Honorary Scholarships with no tuition or boarding fee concession

Scholarship Details:

- Scholarships are determined in open competition at a fixed level set by the school and are non-negotiable
- Scholarships are made at the discretion of the Head of School
- The number of scholarships can vary from year to year depending upon the caliber of candidates who apply
- All scholarships are reviewed on a quarterly basis to assure that attainment and commitment are being maintained at the standard expected of an academic scholar. Scholarships may be withdrawn at any time if a scholar does not maintain the expected standards
- A Stonehill Scholarship is a prestigious award and unashamedly targets the very best scholars. As a step to an excellent university, it is of significant benefit to a student

Who May Apply?

Scholarships are open to all students. Students who apply for M3 must be 13+ years old, M4 must be 14+ years old, M5 must be 15+ years old and D1 must be 16+ years old by 1st September 2018. Students who have a parent or guardian employed by a company that pays or reimburses their employees' school fees are only eligible to apply for an Honorary Scholarship. Similarly, existing Stonehill students are also eligible only for the Honorary Scholarship. Students who have a parent or guardian who is a member of the Senior Management Team of Stonehill are ineligible to apply for either type of scholarship.

Scholarship Application Process:

- Completion of Application Form
- Scholarship Assessment Day for long-listed candidates (Test, Group Discussion and Interview)
- Scholarships announced

- Application deadline: 15 November 2017
- Invitations for Assessment Day: 23 November 2017
- Scholarship Assessment Day: 9 December 2017
